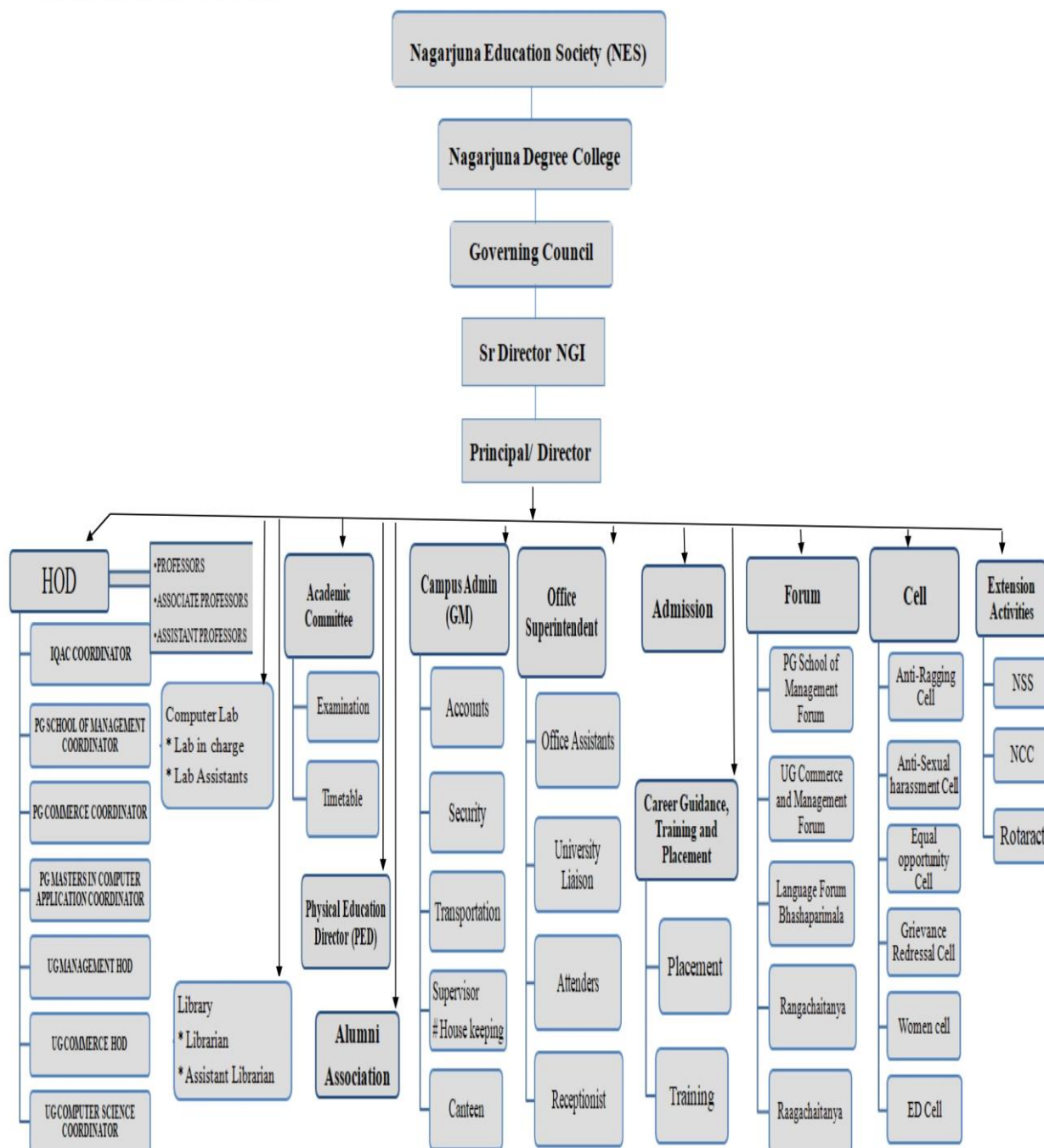





19. Best Practices adopted, if any

(a) The Practice of Mentoring:

It is one of the best practices of the institution. It believes in providing the support to the students to excel not only academically but also develop their personality holistically.

Objectives:“Mentoring” provides support to every student by:

1. Identifying strengths, weaknesses - providing the necessary support to excel through academics, sports / cultural activities
2. Guiding to choose a career and develop a bond with the family/peers that is free from pressure and coercion.
3. Creating a conducive environment in the campus free from oppression, bullying, discrimination and any kind of threat

The Context

Our college has students who hail from middle/low socio-economic groups. At this stage of education, students feel that they neither belong to teen age group nor are adults. They are vulnerable to habits and behaviors that may harm them, their family and society as a whole. Additionally, they take on tremendous pressure to excel and equip themselves with skill sets necessary to ‘fit’ in the job market. At this juncture, to have a friend, philosopher and guide who is well informed and empathizes with them would be meaningful. Presence of mentor teachers with whom they share a bond, who can support and guide them would be helpful.

Evidence of Success

- ❖ There is increased participation of students in sports, curricular and co-curricular activities.
- ❖ Community outreach activities have seen positive impact. Students have initiated programmes on multiple themes- health, environment, legal support etc. The number of students participating in community activities has increased significantly
- ❖ Academic performance of the students has also improved. Remedial programmes are incorporated for underachievers, while the high achievers involve in Peer Mentoring Programme or are inducted to various committees based on their capacities.
- ❖ Interdisciplinary issues of the students were reduced after mentoring.
- ❖ Parent’s participation has been positive with assurance of the welfare of their wards.

(b) Student Study Circle

The research cell of the college encourages students of different semesters to present research papers in study circle activity. In the second week of every month the students in a

group of two or three present research papers on their topic of interest, with the support and guidance of the faculty members. Paper presentation plays an extravagant role in the student's life. There are many advantages of presenting a paper. The students are able to foster critical thinking and analytical skills through hands-on learning. It helps them to define academic, career and personal interests. It also improves their research and presentation skills. It benefits the students in expanding their knowledge and understanding of a chosen field outside of the classroom.

Learning and Evidence of Success

- The students of UG and PG were able to expand interests in various topics of research.
- They benefited by training and development in research from the faculty members who guided them in their research papers.
- The students were able to interact and share ideas with both peers and mentors.
- It is an opportunity for young researchers to learn about the research areas from their peers to increase their capacity in multidisciplinary researcher areas.
